Ashes Interments

The cremated remains of loved ones can be commemorated in several ways:

- Memorial Gardens
- Liquidambar Lane
- Memorial Tree
- Wall of Remembrance
- Memorial Rocks;
- Natural Burial Scattering area; and
- Columbarium niches in our mausoleum

Crematoria provide families with a standard ashes container. Families can choose to inter the ashes in this container or transfer them into an ornate urn. Ornate urns can be kept at home or interred. Other families choose to scatter their loved ones' ashes at a special sight or pour them into the place of interment. Another option is to inter the ashes in an already established interment sight of other loved ones.
