

CANBERRA CEMETERIES INFORMATION SHEET



Memorial Gardens



Available at Gungahlin and Hall Cemeteries, a Memorial Garden allotment is an ashes grave, with memorialisation by way of a plaque installed on the kerb bordering the Memorial Garden.

The memorial plaque is included in the cost of the allotment. In accordance with Canberra Cemeteries policy, only one set of ashes can be interred in a Memorial Garden allotment.

Prior to the interment, Canberra Cemeteries requires the completion of an Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment and an Application for Burial, as well as a copy of the Cremation Certificate.

Interments can take place seven days of the week.

Fresh flowers only are permitted at the grave.

Canberra Cemeteries discourages any placement of personal, valuable or sentimental items on the site.
