



**ACT Public Cemeteries Authority** 

Located at Gungahlin Cemetery, the Wall of Remembrance offers families a unique place to inter the ashes of their loved ones and features a metallic blue memorial plaque installed on a granite wall. The ashes can be interred in the underground vault or behind a plaque

**Fees:** The applicable fee includes for each: an allotment fee; an interment fee; a one-off maintenance fee (in perpetuity); and a plaque fee. There is an additional cost to have the ashes interred behind the plaque.

**Process: Process:** Prior to an interment taking place, Canberra Cemeteries requires the completion of appropriate forms which can be obtained from Canberra Cemeteries or your funeral director.

## **Wall of Remembrance Gungahlin**

Ashes interments can take place Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 3:30pm. If the family does not want to be present during the ashes interment, Canberra Cemeteries will do the interment on their behalf and the family will be notified afterwards. Most families choose to have the plaque in place prior to interring ashes, however this is not a Canberra Cemeteries requirement. A temporary marker will be placed if the plaque is not available.

Upon receiving the completed plaque application form, Canberra Cemeteries will request the plaque proof, which is then sent to the Exclusive Rights Holder (ERH)\* for review. The plaque proof will need to be approved and returned to Canberra Cemeteries before the plaque can be ordered. The approximate timeframe for delivery and installation is 4-6 weeks from the day the plaque is ordered. The ERH will be notified when the plaque has been installed.

Canberra Cemeteries will not be responsible for any personal, valuable or sentimental items that are placed at the grave.



\*The Exclusive Rights Holder of the Allotment is the persons(s) who completes the Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment form prior to the burial occurring or at the time of the allotment purchase. They become the sole authority on any future matters regarding the allotment, including burials and memorialisation.
