Wall of Remembrance



Available at Gungahlin Cemetery, a Wall of Remembrance allotment is an ashes grave, located in an undercover structure. It features a memorial plaque installed on a stone wall. The ashes are placed in the underground vault. A portion of the ashes can also be interred behind the memorial plaque for an additional fee.

The memorial plaque is included in the allotment fees. In accordance with Canberra Cemeteries policy, only one set of ashes can be interred in a Wall of Remembrance allotment.

Prior to interment, Canberra Cemeteries requires the completion of an Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment and an Application for Burial, as well as a copy of the Cremation Certificate.

Interments can take place Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 3:30pm.

Canberra Cemeteries discourages any placement of personal, valuable or sentimental items in the area.
